As discussed with you on the phone (July 16, 1984), approval is hereby granted to U. S. Steel to use a scoop with an eight (8) foot bucket to clear dense brush around the vegetation reference area to facilitate fencing and maintenance of the reference area.

The Division realizes actual clearing may exceed eight feet (8) wide on corners and other trouble spots, however, addition width (over 8') should be kept to a minimum.
