Dear Mr. Sides:

As you are aware the permitting process for the Wellington Preparation Plant is in an advanced stage. One of the obstacles which remains is related to stipulations requiring certain information prior to the issuance of a permit.

In the interest of eliminating those obstructions which are easily addressed we ask at this time that you provide the following information at your earliest convenience.

Stipulation 817.22-(2-3)-TLP

Prior to permit approval the operator must revise the text on page II-5 to increase the removal depth or to return to the removal depth figures previously presented and increase the aerial extent of the borrow area correspondingly. In accordance with this a revised map depicting the new boundary and aerial extent of the substitute topsoil borrow area must be submitted.
