Re: Permit Transfer Request, Wellington Preparation Plant,
ACT/007/012, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

Your request, received August 9, 1989, for transfer of the permit for the Wellington Coal Preparation Plant from Kaiser Coal Corporation to Genwal Coal Company (Genwal) has been reviewed.

The package submitted is deficient in information required by rule UMC 788.18. Genwal may not publish the permit transfer action until the required information has been received.

The deficiencies are as follows:

UMC 782.13 Identification of Interests

- (b)(1) The application does not contain addresses of the officers and directors of Genwal Coal Company.
- (b)(2) The application does not contain the address of Nevada Electric Investment Company (NEICO).
- (c) The application must include names and addresses of NEICO's principals, officers and resident agent.
- (b)(3) and (d) The applicant must indicate permits held by the applicant or principal shareholder as required, including the Crandall Canyon Mine and permits obtained by Big Horn Coal Company.

UMC 782.14 Compliance Information

The application must contain a listing of violations received by the applicant (Genwal Coal Company) during the past three years, and the resolution of each violation.

UMC 782.19 Identification of other Licenses and Permits

The applicant must identify and show the status of all permits required for operation of the Wellington Preparation Plant (including NPDES, MSHA, water rights, etc.). There should be an indication that these permits have been, or will be in the near future, transferred to Genwal.

UMC 782.21 Newspaper Advertisement and Proof of Publication

An affidavit of publication for the permit transfer should be filed with the Division within four weeks of the date of publication.

The information required here regarding ownership and control has recently been submitted as revised Chapter 2 for the Crandall Canyon Mine and should be readily available to you. A list of licenses and permits for the Wellington Plant can be found in the current Mining and Reclamation Plan.

As soon as this information has been supplied the Division will notify you to publish notice as required by UMC 788.18(b)(1). Please also submit a copy of your proposed publication notice with your response.
