
On April 25, 1991 the Division received an amendment requesting approval to remove coal fines from the Wellington Prep Plant slurry cells. The amendment was reviewed and a deficiency letter was sent out on June 19, 1991. Additional information was received at the Division's office on July 15, 1991 addressing the deficiencies. At this time the Division's concerns have been adequately addressed.

The Division hereby approves your amendment to remove enough coal fines to determine the feasibility of removing fines from the entire slurry cell sites. This approval only covers the feasibility study. An additional amendment will need to be submitted if further fines removal is considered.

Please remember the environmental commitments you have made and bear in mind that monthly reporting to the Division is part of this amendment. The Division will look forward to hearing from you regarding how the project is progressing.

Additional copies of this amendment are needed for distribution to other agencies. Please submit seven (7) copies insertable to your mine plan by September 23, 1991. Remember that maps and designs must be certified by a registered professional engineer. Feel free to call if you have any questions.
