I am writing in behalf of Castle Valley Resources and Genwal Coal Company regarding a Permanent Waste Storage Area.

Approval was previously granted for the use of a temporary storage area for waste material from the Crandall Canyon Mine at the Wellington Preparation Plant area in a letter by the Division dated July 3, 1991.

This letter is to inform the Division that Castle Valley Resources/Genwal intends to make this area a Permanent Spoil Storage Area. The spoils from the mine would include the 600 cys of wastes from the mine. Additionally, it is also requested that the Wellington area be the site for permanent storage of non-hazardous waste from clean-out material of the sediment pond at the mine (estimated to be 10,000 cys over the life of the mine).

Responsibility for bonding and reclamation will be addressed in the MRP for the Wellington area currently being prepared and due to be submitted December 1, 1991.
