The recent close-out activity for the 1991 Oversight Year has revealed that the Albuquerque Field Office (AFO) had not rendered a final written finding, pursuant to 30 CFR 842.11, regarding the above-noted TDN. Therefore, please consider the following as the final disposition of the TDN:

On September 10, 1990, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (DOGM) submitted additional documentation regarding the TDN, as requested by AFO in correspondence dated August 31, 1990. Based on AFO's review of the supplemental documentation and DOGM's initial response, AFO will withdraw the TDN.
