Summary :

This memo addresses the package submitted on September 20, 1991, in response to the Division's August 21, 1991 approval letter requesting additional copies of the temporary spoil storage area amendment(TSSAA).

Analysis:

Although the operator did include information listed in the approved (TSSA) the September 20, 1991 submittal was not a copy of the approved amendment but, was instead, an additional amendment to the MRP presently under review.

The information submitted contains new information and, therefore, is not considered a part of the approved (TSSA). The reason for submitting 10 additional copies is to provide other agencies with updated approved mining plan amendments, to be included in their copy of the presently approved MRP. At the present time, the "new" MRP submittal is will soon be reviewed.

Compliance:

Although the operator has attempted to submitted information requested, and has submitted the information to be inserted into the "new" MRP, the operator has not met the requirements for the intended purpose.

Recommendation:

The Division should accept the submitted information as an amendment to the PAP submitted on July 15, 1991 and updated on September 3, 1991. Review of the information would then occur as part of the "new" MRP. The applicant still must submit 10 copies of the approved amendment for distribution to other agencies.
