Re: Affidavit of Publication, Castle Valley Resources, Wellington Preparation Plant, ACT/007/012, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed a review of the recent newspaper advertisement for the transfer of the Wellington Prep Plant to Castle Valley Resources. It appears that there are a few errors with the notice which will need to be corrected. A corrected notice will then need to be published and a 30 day public comment period incurred prior to approval for the permit transfer.


The errors are as follows:

- 1) The publication lists all of section 18 as part of the permit area. This should be all of section 16. Section 18 is not part of the permit area.
- 2) The publication lists Genwal Coal Company as the present permittee, but does not indicate who the new permittee will be. Castle Valley Resources must be identified as the recipient of the transferred permit.
- 3) The permit number is listed as ACT/015/032. This is the number for the Crandall Canyon Mine not the Wellington site. The permit number for Wellington is ACT/007/012.
- 4) No provision for public comment was provided in the notice. The notice should state; that written comments or requests for informal conferences on the application for transfer may be submitted to the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining, 355 West North Temple, 3 Triad Center, Suite 350, Salt Lake City, Utah 84180-1203.
