Re: Temporary Spoil Storage Area, Genwal Coal Company, Wellington Prep. Plant, ACT/007/012, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

This letter addresses the package submitted on September 20, 1991, in response to the Division's August 21, 1991 approval letter requesting additional copies of the temporary spoil storage area amendment. Your September 20, 1991 submittal was not a copy of the approved amendment but, was instead, an additional amendment to the MRP presently under review.

The information you submitted contains new information and, therefore, is not considered a part of the approved Temporary Spoil Storage Area. The reason for submitting 10 additional copies is to provide other agencies with updated approved mining plan amendments, to be included in their copy of the presently approved MRP. At the present time, the "new" MRP submittal is not yet approved. The Division will accept the submitted information as an amendment to the PAP submitted on July 15, 1991 and updated on September 3, 1991. Please note that the package submitted will be reviewed as part of the "new" MRP. You still must resubmit 10 copies of the approved amendment for distribution to other agencies.

Please submit 10 copies of the approved temporary spoil storage area amendment by October 7, 1991. If there are any questions, please call me or Sharon Falvey, Reclamation Hydrologist.
