Re: Deficiencies, Temporary Spoil Storage Area Submittal, Genwal Coal Company, Wellington Prep Plant, ACT/007/012-91B, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

On August 21, 1991, the Division received copies of your temporary spoil storage submittal for the Wellington Prep Plant. These copies do not meet the requirements of the Division and are unacceptable as submitted. Although the Division approved the temporary storage of refuse at the site, the Wellington plan does not address this use. The Division's approval letter of July 3, 1991 specifically asked for an amendment which would be insertable to the MRP. The copies do not appear to amend the Wellington plan and are not insertable to the plan.


We are returning the copies to you and request you make the necessary changes to bring the Wellington Operation Plan up to date with regard to refuse disposal. This would involve submitting revised pages of the plan and a revised map of the surface facilities area, which would include the refuse disposal site. Remember that these plans should be done under the direction of a Registered Professional Engineer and certified as such.

In the future when amending Wellington or Crandall Canyon plans, you should make certain that your submittal is insertable to the plan so that we can maintain a congruous document. Simple letters requesting a change will not be entertained.
