4a. Diversions -

The diversions were inspected and additional maintenance was performed since the last inspection due to an intense rain storm. I suggested to the operator to purchase a rain guage and set it up on site to determine if rain events take place.

4b. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments -

The sediment ponds and impoundments were inspected and discharging was not occurring during the inspection. The ponds had no signs of erosion regarding to inlets, outlets and embankments.

The Division has sent a letter to properly identify the slurry ponds as coal waste impoundments and to correct the language in the mid-term review. The operator will have to comply with all regulations related to the coal waste impoundments.

Note: This inspection report does not constitute an affidavit of compliance with the regulatory program of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining.


