1. Permit -

- a. Sediment Ponds -The sediment ponds by the main office has Division approval to conform with state regulations. These ponds are within the right-of-way of the railroad. A letter of permission is needed by Genwal before the modifications can be implemented. Genwal has been trying to receive written permission for several months from the railroad.
- b. Diversions -All diversions were filled with snow. There was no drainage or snow melt occurring during the inspection.

16a. Roads -

The main gate road is the only road in which snow was removed. The Prep Plant is shipping on occasions; therefore, not all the roads are maintained.


