Dear Mr. Mower:

The Division has completed a review of NEICO's application for transfer of the Wellington Permit ACT/007/012, from Castle Valley Resources to Nevada Electric Investment Company. A number of problems have been identified with the application, many of which deal with conflicting information or information that needs to be clarified. The enclosed memo written by Paul Baker discusses the deficiencies. You should review it and respond to the deficiencies as quickly as possible in order for us to complete the review of your application.

You should also be aware that a reclamation agreement will need to be filed and a bond showing NEICO as principal posted with the Division prior to the transfer being approved.

In the meantime we are continuing to process your application with the information that is currently available. This includes a check through the Applicant Violator System (AVS).

You should also publish a notice of the application for transfer in a paper of local circulation and allow for a public comment period of thirty days following the notice.
