RE: Stipulation for the Five-Year Permit Renewal, Nevada Electric Investment Corporation, Wellington Preparation Plant, Folder #2, ACT/007/012, Carbon County, Utah

SYNOPSIS

On December 8, 1994 I was notified by a fellow staff member that the Five-Year Permit Renewal for the Wellington Preparation Plant would be finalized on December 8, 1994. The permittee submitted a response to the Division's deficiencies on November 10, 1994. I was given the permittee's deficiency response on or around November 28, 1994. The Division's Permit Change Tracking Form indicated that the initial review of the deficiency response was due on December 12, 1994.

Today was the only day this writer had to review the permittee's response. Therefore supporting data and information submitted have not been thoroughly investigated. Given these circumstances an informed technical finding as to the adequacy of the permittee's response can not be rendered by this writer at this time. However, based on the cursory review conducted by this writer many issues remain unresolved and the following five-year permit renewal stipulation is recommended for insertion into the permit and findings document.

STIPULATION NO. 1

R645-301-553.250 (HS) *By January 15, 1995 the permittee must submit, for Division review and inclusion in the Mining and Reclamation Plan, a plan (with appurtenant reclamation designs and reclamation bond) which commits to covering all coal mine waste with a minimum of four feet of the best available, nontoxic, nonacid forming and noncombustible material.*
