Dear Mr. Marshall:

The Division has completed a review of your submittals intended to modify the Refuse Basin Pond, the Slurry Pipeline Pond, the Road Pond, the Auxiliary Pond and the Dryer Sediment Pond at the Wellington Prep Plant. Although the plans for these ponds have come in various submittals we are treating them as one amendment which has been given the number 92B. Your plans have been found to be complete and adequate and are hereby approved for insertion to your Operation and Reclamation Plan with the stipulation that you also provide the following information.

1. The sediment storage volummes for the Road Pond the Auxiliary Pond, and the Dryer Pond.
2. Designs for the emergency and principle spillways for the Dryer pond showing the spillways' discharge capacities and the velocity of the design storm event.

Please submit the above information along with 7 copies of the entire pond amendment 92B by no later than May 6, 1994, for insertion to your Operation and Reclamation Plan and for distribution to other agencies.
