

Dear Mr. Longworth:

This letter is in response to your fax to Tom Mitchell, Assistant Attorney General, on March 6, 1996 about proposed sureties for the Wellington Preparation Plant. It appears that you are suggesting self-bonding for the entire surety amount for the Wellington Preparation plant. The proposed guarantor of Coalplex's self-bond would be American Reclamation and Dismantling/Hiuka America Corporation. The Division cannot agree to self-bonding for the Wellington Preparation Plant, particularly in light of the fact that the reclamation liability for the plant is now secured entirely by corporate surety.

On March 1, 1996, in a conversation between you and Lowell Braxton, you mentioned that the proposed guarantor of the reclamation liability would be Fidelity Secured Deposit Corporation. You were faxed information that day with a note that the "Depository" idea was conceptually okay. However, the language creating the deposit and creating the Division's rights in the deposited sums would need to be acceptable to the Division, and you should contact Tom Mitchell with the particulars. No communication about Fidelity Secured Deposit Corporation has been received to date.
