1. PERMIT -

- a) The slurry ponds were inspected weekly and the last inspection was 2/27/96. There was no report of any hazardous conditions.
- b) The insurance accord form was reviewed and being in compliance with the R645 regulations. The insurance will expire on 2/15/97.
- c) The water monitoring report was taken for surface and ground water on 12/14/95. All parameters were taken.
- d) The annual sediment pond inspection by a P.E. was taken on 12/19/95. No hazardous conditions reported.
- e) The SPPC plan will need to be reviewed by a certified person by 12/6/96.
- f) There was no discharging of all the NPDES point source discharge points for 4th quarter.
- g) The refuse piles were inspected for fourth quarter on 12/14/96. No hazardous conditions reported.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS -

The identification signs have been changed to reflect the correct addresses and phone numbers of the permittee.

4B. SEDIMENT PONDS -

The sediment ponds were inspected with no hazardous conditions being noticed. The ponds contained little or no water. The auxiliary pond may need to be cleaned out this year as indicated in the Annual Report. There were no signs of erosion to pond structures.

7. REFUSE PILES -

The amendment to MSHA for having out slopes greater than 2H:1V has not been reviewed at this time.
