Dear Mr. Brown:

The Division has completed a review of the transfer application received on December 13, 1995 which requested transfer of the Wellington Prep Plant to COVOL. For the most part the application is complete, however there are a couple of items that need to be provided before we can further process the application. The most important item (required by R645-301-123) is the notarized signature of a responsible official of the applicant, that the information contained in the application is true and correct to the best of the official's information and belief. Both COVOL and NEICO should supply these statements.

Covol also needs to provide evidence of adequate insurance coverage as required by R645-301-890.

Lastly, it is not clear in the application who the point of contact should be. The name of the person responsible for correspondence and for payment of abandoned Mine Land Fee should be supplied.

Please provide the above-referenced information by no later than January 30, 1996. Once these issues have been adequately addressed, it is anticipated that the public notice required by R645-303-322 can proceed. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call.
