

Enclosed for your review are the pages of text and maps for the Wellington Modular Coal Fines Wash Plant that replaces and supersedes the amendment submitted to your office on June 30, 1997. This replacement amendment was created to respond to the DOGM's technical questions and comments. As you will note, revisions have been made to replacement pages submitted on June 30, and additional replacement pages have been included to Chapters 2 and 7. Reclamation bonding calculations have been included as well. These changes have been made to clarify Covol's intent to simply construct the wash plant under this amendment; no operations or processing will occur. A future amendment will more fully address water issues since no pumping of water is planned at this time.
