NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N 98-41-5-1

Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of violation

Failure to conduct all mining and reclamation operations only as described in
the approved application. Failure to locate, maintain, and construct sediment
control measures according to plans and designs in the operation and reclamation
plan. Failure to locate and maintain stockpiled topsoil according to plans in
the operation and reclamation plan.

Coal handling area and topsoil stockpiles along access road.
