Dear Mr. Fogg:

Re: NEICO-Submission of Dust Control Plan-Utah Air Conservation Rules (UACR) Sections 205-6(2) and 205-6(3) Fugitive Emissions and Fugitive Dust, Tailings Piles and Ponds - Carbon County.

Pursuant to Utah Air Conservation Rules (UACR) Sections 307-205-6(2) and 307-205-6(3), the Utah Division of Air Quality (DAQ) requires that NEICO submit a Fugitive Dust Control Plan for the former Covol operations site in Wellington, Utah.

UAC R307-205-6(2) states, in part,:

“Any person owning or operating an existing tailings operation where fugitive dust results from grading, excavating, depositing or natural erosion or other causes in association with such operation shall take steps to minimize fugitive dust from such activities...”

UAC R307-205-6(3) states, in part,:

“Any person owning or operating an existing tailings operation in a nonattainment area for particulate or an existing mining operation outside an actual area of nonattainment from which fugitive dust impacts an actual area of nonattainment for particulate shall submit plans for control of fugitive dust from such operations...”

Numerous complaints from this site indicate that there is inadequate dust control being applied at this time.

Please respond within 10 days upon receipt of this letter. Attached you will find a copy of DAQ’s Dust Control Plan guidelines. Questions regarding this matter may be directed to Anthony DeArcos at (801) 536-4028
