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

Dear Mr. Herkimer:

You requested in a telephone conversation and follow-up email this month that I submit the DMR's from January 1999 through March 2000 (or a summary statement about the discharges). I have submitted the quarterly summaries for these dates indicating no discharges from the NPDES monitoring stations. I also reviewed my monthly field notes for those months indicating no discharges. As you know NEICO is the owner and permittee but Covol is an operator on the east side of the Price River. Therefore, NEICO is responsible for monitoring on the west side and Covol on the east side of the river. The included documents, however, represent the summaries of *both* sides of the Price River.

As indicated above, although the monitoring stations are inspected monthly, the included documents are summaries of the 3 monthly inspections for each quarter. You have indicated that we should submit the monthly reports and not solely the quarterly summaries for those months. In doing so, I have also provided April and May 2000 DMR reports with this letter and will continue this process each month.
