**2. SIGNS AND MARKERS**

Several of the Identification signs were spot-checked and contained the correct information as required in the R645 Coal Rules.

**4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS**

The Diversions were spot-checked and would function as designed during a storm event.

**4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING**

The second quarter water monitoring data was inspected and compared with the laboratory sheets, MRP, and the Division's water monitoring data system. The required parameters were taken for all sites for second quarter. Ground water well GW-11 is plugged and is shown active in the MRP. The permittee must submit an amendment to withdraw this site from the MRP.

**4E. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS**

There was no discharge from Wellington UPDES monitoring sites for second quarter.

**8. NONCOAL WASTE**

The site was clear of noncoal waste material.
