**1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE**

No new amendments have been sent to the Division by the permittee.

**4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS**

The diversions were spot-checked and were found to comply with the requirements of the Mining and Reclamation Plan and the R645 Coal Rules.

**4B. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS**

The sediment ponds were not discharging during the inspection and are not likely to discharge in the near future. These ponds did contain a little or no water. There were no signs of any hazardous conditions during the inspection.

**4C. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES**

The permittee has installed new silt fences along the Siaperas ditch.

**4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING**

The permittee has taken first quarter water monitoring. It was submitted and approved by the Division. This information was entered into the water database system and was confirmed by this inspector. The permittee will be taking water samples for the second quarter prior to the end of the second quarter.

**4E. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS**

There was no discharge of water from the sediment ponds for first and second quarter. Some ponds did contain small amounts of water.
