## **2. Signs and Markers**

The permittee installed new identifications from roads leading to public access. The information contains within the signs meet the R645 Coal Rules. They have also installed new MSHA signs.

## **3. Topsoil**

The topsoil piles were inspected with no signs of wind or water erosion. The topsoil piles were stable.

### **4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions**

Several diversions throughout the property will need cleaning due to the recent rain storms. Sediment has started to build-up within the diversions and culverts.

### **4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**

I inspected the sediment ponds. I did not see any hazardous conditions. Sediment ponds did contain water due to the recent rainstorms. The sediment ponds were not discharging.

### **4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures**

The permittee maybe in the future submit an amendment to change sediment control measures of some ASC areas.

## **7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments**

The refuse piles and slurry ponds were stable. I did not see any hazardous conditions. Maybe in the near future there will be mining of this material.

## **8. Noncoal Waste**

The permittee continues to clean non-coal waste material. The site has never look so good.

No slides or other damage was noticed during the inspection.
