New ID signs have been installed. One sign still needs to be replaced on top of the mountain. The new signs contain new information of the resident agent.


4C. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

Recent high winds had laid a silt fence over. Repairs to the silt fence were made during the inspection.

4D. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: WATER MONITORING

Fourth quarter 2001 water monitoring information has been submitted into the EDI pipeline. First quarter 2002 is current and awaiting lab results. During the inspection L-1-S, L-2-S, and L-3-S were checked. All of the locations were dry with no evidence of recent flow. The atmospheric temperature was 48°F.
