A review of the EDI website prior to the inspection indicated that all the required information for third quarter 2002 has been submitted and uploaded.

**13. REVEGETATION**

The refuse and sediment pond areas that were reclaimed and seeded in 2001 are starting to show minimal growth, perhaps from the recent storm events. It is too early to determine the success and/or diversity of the seeds that have germinated.
