Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig,

On August 24th 2004 UEI submitted some permit updates and changes to the Horse Canyon Permit. The changes requested included clarifications to the revegation standards. On October 26th DOGM responded with a TA identifying deficiencies with a due date of December 10, 2004.

Prior to addressing the deficiencies the Division has requested a site visit. Due to early and persistent snows the Division's visit has yet to take place. It is impossible to address these deficiencies prior to the site visit.

UEI respectfully requests an extension of time to allow for the Division's site visit and to subsequently address the deficiencies. The site visit will take place as soon as weather allows. The Division's visit will take place as soon as possible. However, with the amount of snow and we are entering into the winter season, a visit may not be possible until the spring thaw. Therefore, UEI requests the response time to be extended to May 1, 2005.
