The Utah State Historic Preservation Office received the referenced information on March 10, 2005. After consideration of the consultation request in behalf of the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining, the Utah Preservation Office provides the following comments per U.A.C. 9-8-404.

Section 404 Consultation DOGM; USHPO concurs with the determination of No Historic Properties Affected for EM 2255 and 2256. The BLM is proposing mitigation for EM 2517, therefore a determination of Adverse Effect is appropriate for EM 2517. However, the BLM recovery plan for site EM2517 will likely mitigate that adverse effect. Of course, that determination rests with the BLM.
