The Denver Field Division (DFD) received a petition to designate Federal lands in Utah unsuitable for surface coal mining. On July 25, 2006, a petition was submitted by the Southern Utah Wilderness Alliance (SUWA). The petition identifies 5,544 acres for which Federal coal has been leased to Utah American Energy. The petition is concerned with cultural, scientific and aesthetic resources and potential effects of subsidence.
