Subject: Note on Horse Canyon Refuse Pile Channel

I called Dave Shaver this afternoon 10/13/06 (Friday). I asked if Jay or Tom S. had contacted him about my concerns about the Horse Canyon Channel Repairs. I explained to Dave as I had explained to Jay 2 day ago and Tom S. yesterday (Thursday) that I had concerns about the steepness of the southwest embankment of the channel, the way the rocks (riprap) was pushed up against the side and how there were voids between some of the large boulders. Dave said it was the first time he had heard of my concerns.

Jay said in our phone conversation that he would contact Tom S. and we should put a meeting together to look at what I thought were the problems. Jay didn't call back as of Thursday, but Tom S. did. I was at the phone, but the transfer didn't come through. I called Jay back and told him my concerns. He said he had been on site and was about to prepare the cross-sections requested for reconstruction.

Dave expressed his assurance, he thought the channel had been reconstructed (by Mark) to meet or exceed the design standards. We discussed a meeting. He stated he could not meet today on such notice. I told him I will be out of the office next week. I told him I could call him on the Monday after I return. I stated he should contact Jay and Tom S. to get their opinions as to a meeting and my concerns.
