Steve, thank you for clarifying that the Division is not required to deny the permit on March 8, 2007 in the event that the permit is not issued by that date. As you know UEI is working hard to assure that the Division can meet this timeframe for issuance of the permit. UEI would like an opportunity to meet with BLM and the Division to review the terms of the draft PA as soon as possible. It is not UEI's intent to delay the permitting process and towards that end, UEI has agreed to be removed as a signatory to the PA. Please let me know when a meeting time has been set with the BLM. As you know, BLM is a required signatory to the PA and so we are not going to send out the draft PA until we have a chance to review your comments and meet again with BLM.
