Purpose: UEI/Agency Review of Comments on draft PA for Cultural Resources and permit status – see agenda proposed by UEI, attached

MEETING SUMMARY:

1. PA - Concerns about the draft PA were posed by UEI and answered by OGM and PLPCO. UEI does not wish to sign PA. OGM posed options of having the PA as a permit stip. In that way, UEI signs when it signs the permit. Explained that this would be a more difficult and time-consuming option. UEI said they might appeal it.
2. Status of Response to January 19, 2007 Modification, deficiency lists. – UEI is still working on List #1. Have submitted response on 3 of 4 on List 1. UEI said it would try to get List #1 complete 'sometime next week.' List #2 – UEI thinks it has addressed most of them.
3. Ownership and Control (from List 3)– There are 45 deficiencies that need to be addressed by UEI. D. Dragoo addressed a few of these. These take time and will need to be done by the time of permit issuance. Diligence is called for.

PROPOSED ACTION ITEMS:

PA – Take UEI off as a signer; make it a permit stip.

UEI – to finish addressing List #1, #2, #3.
