As you know, the E Shoshone requested to conduct a cultural inventory (different than an archeological survey) at the expense of the Permittee.

We discussed this request at our meeting last week and the consensus was that it was a bit too late for that request - that the tribe may have wanted to contact us with their concerns following our "information seeking" letter back in Feb 2006.

The signatories considered that it would be good to ask the Permittee if they would like to host and pay for their visit, but that it is not required.
