The table below was originally compiled from a list provided to Pam from Garth (BLM). However, he did not inform Pam that the final list should be edited based on the project location. So, the two info-seeking letters that went out in early 2006 (~Feb and Mar/May) were sent to all but one of the tribes listed.

In the summer of 2006, we met w. Dr. John Fritz, Dept Chair of Humanities (SLCC) – as a consultant for UEI, to go over the tribal consultation matters. He provided a tribal contact list that 1) provided updated contacts, which some were different from Garth's list, 2) was more specific/appropriate for the coal region, 3) provided one new tribe that had not been contacted previously (Zuni).

During our consultation of our effect and eligibility determinations with the tribes, I received some contact updates and added these to the list.

The tribes listed below were removed from the consulting party list for the Feb 2007 consultation because they requested to be removed from the list, never answered the phone (Feb 2006-May 2006), never returned messages, or were not recommended by Dr. John Fritz.

Southern Ute Indian Tribe, Shoshone Paiute Tribe, Ely Shoshone Tribe, Duckwater Shoshone Tribe, Te-Moak Western Shoshone, Shoshone Bannock Tribe, Skull Valley Band of Goshute Indian Tribe, Kanosh Band of Paiutes, Koosharem Band of Paiutes, Shivwits Band of Paiutes, Moapa Band of Paiutes, Kaibab Band of Paiutes, Navajo Chapters (8), and San Juan Southern Paiutes.
