Jay:

This afternoon we had a conference call with Tom Suchoski to discuss the precipitation data submitted in the Lila Canyon Mine 2009 Annual Report.. The supplemental material provided by Tom helped clear up most of my questions. Tom is going to prepare a revised report with corrections made to the tables and a more legible plate showing gauge locations. Tom will also include the quarterly download summaries from the precip gauges which he sent as .pdf files in his email last night. The 2009 Annual Report will not be re-submitted, and the original Hydrologic Designs report included in the 2009 Annual Report will not be replaced.

We also discussed the data submittal requirements in the Permit Conditions, and agreed that submitting precipitation data from October to October in Annual Reports is a logical and acceptable approach (i.e., the 2010 Annual Report will contain data from October 2009 to October 2010).
