Good morning!

Per our discussion the other day, please find enclosed determination of effect for the Lila Canyon Breakout.

"The Area of Potential Effect (APE) for the Lila Canyon Breakout is defined by a 200 ft. by 400 ft (3.54 acres) proposed breakout location. A class III intensive pedestrian inventory was conducted by Montgomery Archaeological Consultants (Report U-16-MQ-0154b). No historic properties are located within the APE. Pursuant to 36CFR800, a determination of "no historic properties affected" is made.

The proposed project is a small scale routine undertaking that does not exceed the Review Thresholds in Section B of the Programmatic Agreement between the BLM and Utah SHPO. No additional consultation is necessary.
