The above mentioned mine site was visited by Joe Helfrich, D. Wayne Hedberg and Mary Kay Stein with the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining and Larry Damrau, OSM Inspection, Denver, on July 10, 1980. They were accompanied by Don Trepp, Manager of Operations.

The visit was to terminate violations issued June 3, 1980 by OSM. Violations #2,4, and 5 were terminated. No new violations were issued.

The area on the right of the portal near the drainage needs to be graded with a berm next to the fence.

Five culverts have been installed on the county access road. The first culvert from the portal area needs tubing to minimize erosion on the down slope, the second culvert needs to be extended in order to reach the creek. All of the culverts should be staked so as to prevent damage in snow plowing activities. The number five culvert was partially blocked.
