On May 5, 1980 John Nadolski of the Office of Surface Mining called Tom Suchoski of the Division staff and discussed the lease modification stipulations to be placed upon Beaver Creek Coal Company for the Gordon Creek #2 Mine. Several items were missing from the stipulation. Mainly the permanent seed mixture and the bond estimate. The following is the seed mixture which the Office of Surface Mining proposes for the Gordon Creek #2 Mine:

Western wheatgrass	3 lbs./acre
Slender wheatgrass	2 lbs./acre
Indian ricegrass	2 lbs./acre
Fig bluegrass	1/2 lb./acre
American vetch	2 lbs./acre
Western yarrow	1/4 lb./acre

The seed mixture should include two of the following shrubs planted in clumps; snowberry, antelope bitterbrush, serviceberry, mountain mahogany.

The bond estimated by the Office of Surface Mining amounted to \$58,800.00 for reclamation of the Gordon Creek #2 Mine site.
