This mine site was visited on March 25, 1980 by Mary Ann Wright of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, Dan Guy of Beaver Creek Coal Company, Jim Ives and Dave Chenowith of ARCO Coal Company, Larry Dalton of the Division of Wildlife Resources and Clark Johnson of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. All parties visited the site together for the purpose of a wildlife consultation requested by the Company. Mr. Johnson noted concern for the high federal interest bird species which may occur at this site. Mr. Dalton suggested that a raptor inventory be done at this site.

The vegetation at this site ranges from the aspen community into the fir species.

Two maps of this mine site were delivered to the Division of Wildlife Resources.
