Dear Lynn:

Since our last conversation in regards to herbicide control, I have discussed, with my superiors, the feasibility of using 2,4-D LO-V ESTER at such a late time of year.

In order to maximize the kill-ratio with 2,4-D LO-V ESTER, the manufacturers suggest that use be restricted to the times when targeted species are in a rapid growth stage. In Salsola species case, this period occurs in spring. At this time, most of the Salsola is "setting" seed at C.V. Spur and in a growth reduction stage at Gordon Creek #2 Mine.

In the interest of sound, cost-effective management, I feel, as do my superiors, that it would be more advantageous to spray in the spring at the indicated locations.
