Dear Mr. Guy:

The Division has reviewed Beaver Creek Coal Company's proposal for a water system modification at the Gordon Creek #2 Mine. Approval for this modification is granted with the following stipulations: A variance to UMC 817.57 concerning stream buffer zones will be allowed as long as:

- 1a. The original stream channel will not be disturbed.
- b. During and after construction activities, the water quantity and quality of the stream section where activities are within 100 feet of the stream shall not be adversely affected. Temporary monitoring points will be established on the stream immediately above and below this section.
2. The applicant must implement sediment and drainage control methods during construction in accordance with UMC 817.45 to minimize erosion and prevent, to the extent possible, additional sediment contributions to the stream. This should include berming the road and pump area and seeding the pump area after construction.
3. The applicant must supply to the Division proof that the "right-of-entry" requirements for landowners (UMC 782.15) have been met.
4. The applicant must provide plans for reclamation of this modification in accordance with UMC 784.13, .14 and .15.
