Determination of Completeness

The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has completed a review of the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) and amendments submitted by Beaver Creek Coal Company for the Gordon Creek #2 Mine. The Division has determined the plan to be apparently complete. In compliance with Section UMC 786.11(a) of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UMC, Section 40-10-1 et seq.), notice is hereby given to the general public that a complete plan is available for public review for this proposed operation.

The Gordon Creek #2 Mine is located in Bryner Canyon, approximately 20 road miles northwest of Price, Utah. The following are the legal descriptions of the permit area:
