Dear Ms. Boucek:

Beaver Creek Coal Company is anticipating the need to remove snow from the disturbed area storage at the Gordon Creek No. 2 and 7 Mines this winter. No. 7 Mine may not have sufficient underground material storage space developed by winter; therefore, some of the surface storage area may have to be used for material storage, reducing the snow storage capacity.

If snow must be hauled from the site, it is our proposal to take it to the old #3 Mine portal pad area. This area is inactive, but maintained, and will drain into the sedimentation ponds.

This is a temporary measure, since the #3/6 Mine area will be reclaimed in the fall of 1985; however, by that time, additional storage areas will be available at the #2 and #7 Mine sites.

It is our hope this plan will meet with your approval. Please let me know if you have any questions or need any further information.
