Per your request, Beaver Creek Coal Company is submitting two copies of modified text and maps for our Gordon Creek No. 2 Mine Permanent Program Permit to Mine Application. The changes are being made in order to include necessary information on the Gordon Creek Road from the mine gate to the Consumer Canyon unimproved road.
