Dear Mr. Smith:

As discussed with you over the telephone on April 18, Beaver Creek Coal Company is planning to clean the sediment from their sedimentation pond at the Gordon Creek No. 2 Mine. We also intend to remove the snow-waste that has been piled above the pond over the winter.

The sediment from the pond will be hauled to the C.V. Spur refuse disposal area as agreed. The snow-waste will be hauled to the Gordon Creek No. 3 Mine and spread in the coal loadout area so it can melt quickly. Runoff from the melted snow-waste will be captured by the No. 3 Mine sedimentation pond system. These ponds are currently dry.
