In a telephone conversation with Scott Grace of the Office of Surface Mining (OSM), Western Technical Center, on April 12, 1984, Mr. Grace informed me that the summary of the Cumulative Hydrologic Impact Assessment (CHIA) which is necessary for the decision document of the Gordon Creek #2 permit review process will be delayed. The source of the delay apparently is that certain sections must be rewritten pursuant to directives from Mr. Walt Swain of the OSM, Western Technical Center.

The draft summary of CHIA had been reviewed by Tom Munson of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining and favorable recommendations had been passed onto Scott Grace on April 10, 1984. Scott Grace indicated that he hoped to have the revised summary of the CHIA completed by approximately April 16 or 17, 1984. He also indicated that the conclusions were basically unchanged and that the changes were comprised primarily of rewording certain sections pursuant to Mr. Swain's request.
