It came to the Division's attention on this date (by telephone, L. Hamm, OSM, to M. Boucek, DOGM) Beaver Creek Coal Company (BCCC) has not as yet satisfied BLM comments as outlined in BLM memos dated August 12, 1983 and December 23, 1983 with reference to the Gordon Creek #2 Mine. This was immediately brought to the attention of Dan Guy, BOCC, who in turn discussed outstanding issues directly with Boyd McKeon, BLM. Mr. Guy indicated (by phone to M. Boucek) that BCCC will resolve these outstanding issues by sending a response directly to BLM and 13 copies to the Division for dissemination, the week of March 26th. The Division assumes responsibility for this oversight.

A draft copy of the Cumulative Hydrologic Impact Assessment (CHIA) was delivered to OSM March 16, 1983 by the Contractor. A copy was immediately sent to the Division and the document is currently being reviewed by Scott Grace, OSM, with input from John Whitehead, DOGM. OSM will prepare a CHIA summary the week of March 26 for incorporation into the Final Decision Package which will be sent to Washington.
