The Notice of Violation (NOV) abatement plans submitted by Beaver Creek Coal Company (BCCC) December 16, 1984 for NOV N84-6-13-1 have been reviewed by the Division. The proposed plans are hereby conditionally approved by the Division.

BCCC must provide the Division with written acceptance of the conditions listed below by December 28, 1984. Failure to respond by this date will jeopardize the status of this approval and/or warrant enforcement action. The Company has indicated that construction has been completed per abatement plans. The Division will consider December 6, 1984 as the date of plan implementation.

Condition 12/14/84-3-dh

1. The Company shall monitor the take-up area on the belt transfer for hydraulic fluid leaks and repair as needed.
2. As straw bales have a relatively short span of useful existence as sediment control structures, the Company should commit to the replacement of the bales as needed.
