
The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has received your June 6, 1984 submittal requesting approval to modify and replace the existing men's bathhouse trailers with a single, new bathhouse. Since all work will occur within the present disturbed area, and there will be no changes to existing drainage, sewage, or water line routes, the Division has no objection to this proposal and hereby issues its approval. This revision is considered a minor permit amendment pursuant to UMC 788.12(b).

A copy of this plan has been sent to Mr. Steve McNeal of the State Department of Health by request. They will review the proposal to see if it meets with their approval. You should contact them before initiating construction of the facility to see if any concerns have arisen. In an effort to keep all Mining and Reclamation Plans (MRP's) on file with the respective state and federal agencies current, the Division requests that an additional seven (7) copies of the revised maps be provided to this office for dissemination. An indication by cross reference to the appropriate section in the MRP should also be provided to permit the revision to be inserted directly into the plan.
